The Public Employee Recognition House Bill 6091 is currently before the Michigan House of Representatives Appropriations Committee. The Legislature is entering into its summer recess and will not resume activity until late July. MSEA is currently organizing a action for late summer allowing all our members to be involved in advocating for the passage of this legislation. We will have more information in the near future to assist our members and their families in getting involved.

Knowing your Contract:

Did you know Article 43 of the MSEA CBA also handles travel reimbursements and as a MSEA member you are not required to supply meal receipts? Article 43 § (T) states in pertinent part: *"Employees shall be entitled to travel reimbursements at the rates in accordance with the Standardized Travel Regulations which are in effect on dates of travel, except that meal receipts will not be required"* We are dedicated to keeping our contract provisions on the radar, let's stand in solidarity, upholding each others workplace rights.
