Knowing your Contract:

Did you know the Article 29 provision of the MSEA CBA handles training, licensure and certifications required to do your job? If your classification specification requires you to obtain or retain any licensure or certification, your Department must provide administrative leave for travel and attendance at these trainings. If any disagreements occur over this obligation it is to be considered a proper subject during secondary negotiations. We are dedicated to keeping our contract provisions on the radar, let's make sure to have our collective voices heard.
