MSEA History:

Did you know MSEA was successful advocating on behalf of all State of Michigan employees to be eligible to retire at age 55 with 30 years of service? The fully State paid retirement system was adopted due to a 1974 Bill proposed to the Michigan Legislature by MSEA. Even prior to gaining Collective Bargaining rights in 1980, MSEA was able to stand up for workplace rights for all employees.

Knowing your Contract:

Did you know Article 24 of the MSEA CBA handles supplement employment and secures your ability to an expedited grievance procedure? Article 24 § (6) states in pertinent part: "In the event that supplement employment is denied by the Employer, the employee may file a grievance under the expedited procedure." We are dedicated to keeping our contract provisions on the radar, let's stand in solidarity, upholding workplace rights.
